In graphic design, we use repetition to facilitate the reading or viewing of a document. For instance, in a website you would put the navigation bar in the same position on every page, so the viewer doesn't have to look for them. In a print document, the main elements such as heading, sub headings, and page numbers are always placed and formatted the same way.

Alignment

Alignment makes any document look more organized and also helps the viewers to make senses of the information. Alignment is often referred to as an invisible line that connects elements.


